

COVID-19 POLICY – Updated 7/30/2021

As we begin to return to some normalcy after the year of the COVID-19 pandemic and CDC guidelines are revised, we wanted to update you on the changes at the studio to help keep you, your child, and our staff safe. We are following the current CDC and Dept. of Public Health guidelines to provide a healthy and safe learning environment.

Outlined below are our "Safe Studio" procedures.

- We continue to adhere to our high standards for cleanliness and sanitization of all areas and surfaces.
- All students and teachers will be asked to thoroughly wash their hands or use the provided hand sanitizing stations before and after each class/lesson. Parents will be expected to assist their child as needed.
- Those fully vaccinated against Covid 19 are no longer required to wear face masks. Masks are optional for all children ages 12 and under. Individuals who are **not** vaccinated and over the age of 12 **are required** to wear masks and or face shields. (Mask policies subject to change based on CDC and/or Dept. of Public Health recommendations)
- We will have disinfecting wipes, sprays, and hand sanitizers readily available
- Each student will have their own set of instruments, pencils, crayons, etc. There will be no sharing of supplies in class. All instruments will be cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- In our Let's Play Music classes, we ask that parents assist their child with sanitizing their keyboards, benches, and any shared supplies before leaving the classroom.

Thank you so much to all our students and families for your patience and understanding as we navigated and continue to navigate through this new world in which we live. We are open to any suggestions that you may have in order to make you feel more comfortable and safer when coming to The Music Garden. We love being a part of your lives.
